

SPARKLING ICE WREATH

HERE'S A FUN, EARTH-FRIENDLY WREATH PROJECT.
MAKE THIS for OUTSIDE USE WHEN IT GETS COLD.

SUPPLIES:

Here's what you'll need:

- Round aluminum pie pan and small custard cup or dish (or tube-style cake pan)
- Cranberries
- Pieces of greenery Holly, Cedar, Pine, Boxwood, etc.
- Small pinecones (Optional: Smeared with Peanut Butter)
- Raffia
- Sunflower Seeds Striped are probably best. These are optional but like the peanut butter, birds dig it!

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Put the custard cup in the center of the pie pan or use a tube-style cake pan.
- 2. Arrange cranberries, greenery, and pinecones in the pan as desired.
- 3. Fill with water.
- 4. Freeze in freezer. If weather permits, freeze outdoors.
- 5. Dip the pan in warm water to remove it from the wreath.
- 6. Loop raffia around the wreath and hang outside on a tree branch or hook.
