



SPARKLING ICE WREATH

HERE'S A FUN, EARTH-FRIENDLY
WREATH PROJECT.
MAKE THIS for OUTSIDE USE
WHEN IT GETS COLD.

SUPPLIES:

Here's what you'll need:

- Round aluminum pie pan and small custard cup or dish (or tube-style cake pan)
- Cranberries
- Pieces of greenery - Holly, Cedar, Pine, Boxwood, etc.
- Small pinecones (Optional: Smearred with Peanut Butter)
- Raffia
- Sunflower Seeds - Striped are probably best. These are optional but like the peanut butter, birds dig it!

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Put the custard cup in the center of the pie pan or use a tube-style cake pan.
2. Arrange cranberries, greenery, and pinecones in the pan as desired.
3. Fill with water.
4. Freeze in freezer. If weather permits, freeze outdoors.
5. Dip the pan in warm water to remove it from the wreath.
6. Loop raffia around the wreath and hang outside on a tree branch or hook.
